In December the singles ministry hosted **'Make a Difference Day'** for the whole London church which raised over £500 for Hope (an amount doubled by a company) through carol singing in Covent Garden.

It was a time filled with thanks and praise to God with public reading of scripture and a message to respond to the call that God has for us this year.

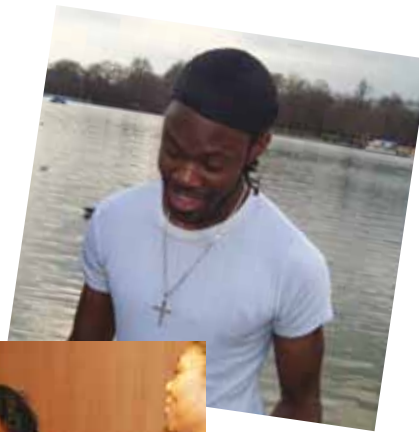

CENTRAL LONDON MULTIPLIES

With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may fulfil every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith. - 2 Thessalonians 1:11

This is the theme passage for the Central London Ministry as we move forward this year, praying that God will fulfil our good purpose to make disciples in the city centre. God has blessed us much since we started in the autumn, growing our group to 22 people with two baptisms so far this year. We welcome JaRoy and Pearl into the kingdom, with more people studying the Bible, well on their way!

We had a special worship service at the end of January for the students, meeting at the University of London Union. Andy Boakye came down from Manchester to give a talk on evidences for the historical Jesus, and the attendance was over 60! The student ministry has since been happy and blessed, having Bible studies with people on four different campuses and our fellowship events growing bigger each week. We have just returned from an encouraging time of fellowship at our **'All UK Student Retreat'**, which was much bigger than the one we had in the autumn, showing that God has been blessing not only London but also Reading, Birmingham, Leicester and Manchester with active new student ministries over the past year.

God has set it on our hearts to not only spread the gospel in the city centre, but also to serve the whole London church. We know that there are many disciples who are members of the "outer" regions yet work in the centre and have colleagues who might not want to travel out to the suburbs for Sunday services. We want to help them reach out to their co-workers by hosting evangelistic events for them in the centre. Our first one is Thursday 18 March - a talk by Rob Payne entitled: **God, the Big Bang and Evolution: Can We Believe in All Three?** If you're able to come, details are on the website.

We appreciate all the prayers and support we've received from everyone, and for the many wise and inspiring leaders who have come to preach for us. Please keep praying for us (2 Cor 1:11) and we're sure God will continue to bless our acts prompted by faith! All glory to Him!
